About the Role

Oversee client care and medical service operations in our pregnancy resource center clinic. This part-time, hourly position allows you to combine your clinical skills with ministry, providing essential medical services while maintaining the highest standards of care and pro-life values.

Key Responsibilities

Client Care

- Provide client and clinical services in accordance with expertise and training
- Explain medical consent forms thoroughly and answer client questions
- Document client care in charts and maintain patient medical records
- Provide health education on pregnancy options, STDs/STIs, and other relevant topics
- Offer referrals for medical care, follow-up, and community resources
- Conduct phone follow-up with clients as indicated
- Communicate regularly with the Medical Director for ongoing clinical supervision

Medical Operations Management

- Ensure accurate implementation of the Medical Director's orders
- Conduct quarterly patient record audits
- Maintain staff medical records and provide in-service education as needed
- Implement clinic policies, including OSHA, CLIA, privacy practices, and infection control
- Conduct annual review of policies and procedures with the Medical Director
- Orient new medical staff to clinic duties and responsibilities



Supervision & Leadership

- Supervise nurses, sonographers, and clinic medical volunteers
- Conduct annual evaluations of nurses and sonographers
- Coordinate medical staff schedules

Facility & Equipment Management

- Ensure medical equipment is properly operated and maintained
- Conduct regular medical supply inventory and ordering
- Ensure proper disinfection of medical equipment and exam rooms
- Monitor organization's OSHA compliance

Emergency Response

- Follow guidelines for responding to emergencies and unusual ultrasound findings per established protocols

Professional Development

- Maintain active nursing license and state continuing education requirements
- Maintain CPR certification
- Obtain additional certifications as requested (limited obstetrical ultrasound, STD/STI certification, etc.)

Qualifications

Required:

- Current Texas nursing license in good standing
- Committed Christian faith with active church involvement; agreement with W2W's Statement of Principle and Faith
- Pro-life position alignment
- 1+ year experience as a nurse in a clinical setting
- Knowledge of human reproduction, pregnancy, abortion, and related health issues
- Ability to communicate with diverse populations verbally and in writing
- Problem-solving, analytical, and critical thinking skills
- Strong organizational skills and proven dependability
- Ability to lift up to 25 pounds
